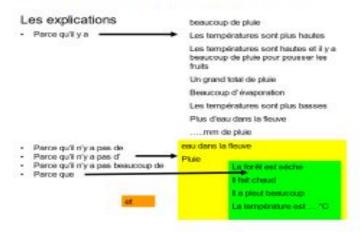

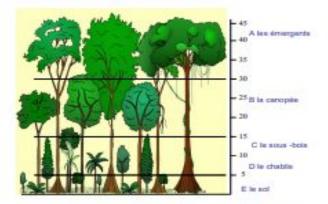

Tropical Rainforests lesson 6 -8 Rainforest structure and adaptation of rainforest animals and plants



First assessment . The first assessment is to produce a drawing of rainforest structure and to choose an area of the world where there is a tropical forest . Within that area, students choose five plants and five animals and research their adaptations. They draw the plants and animals or stick pictures of them onto the structure to show where they are found. They also include writing in French to explain the adaptations.

STRUCTURE OF THE COURSE

- Transition: Year 6
- Year 7
- Year 8
- Geography one hour a week alongside other subjects if possible to create a European Curriculum where students have as many MFL lessons as they have in English. Most Secondary schools have 2hours of MFL so if you add one hour of Geography, one of PSHE and tutorial time input you could have a European curriculum and make a huge impact on MFL and progress and attainment across the whole curriculum.
- Other subjects I have used as part of the programme include Science, ICT, Business Studies, PE, RE.
- One hour of CLIL a week will make a huge impact.
- Separate units rather than a whole year course may be a good way to start but you need to build up to a whole year course to have impact across a whole school.
